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NEW BUSINESS:

- **10' Pusher Blade:** Following a discussion on the blade, Lorrissa Anderson made a motion to purchase for \$1,350. Hunter Goldsby seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Bill Drake, Hunter Goldsby, Lorissa Anderson and Carolyn Brunken. Voting Nay: None – MOTION CARRIED
- **Payroll:** The Board discussed the State requirement for Board Members and the Clerk/Treasurer to be identified as employees and made the following motions:
 - **Chairman wage to increase from \$20.00/Meeting to \$25.00/Meeting**
 - **Trustees and Co-Chairman wage to increase from \$15.00/Meeting to \$20.00 per Meeting.**
 - Hunter Goldsby made a motion to approve the increases for Board Members as discussed, Carolyn Brunken seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Bill Drake, Hunter Goldsby, Lorissa Anderson and Carolyn Brunken. Voting Nay: None – MOTION CARRIED
 - **Clerk/Treasurer Wage increase from \$275/Month to \$400/Month**
 - Lorissa Anderson made a motion to approve the increase for Clerk/Treasurer as discussed, Bill Drake seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Bill Drake, Hunter Goldsby, Lorissa Anderson and Carolyn Brunken. Voting Nay: None – MOTION CARRIED
- **John Templin – Rehab Loan:** Clerk presented the new proposal with John's approval to the Board for reconsideration for the roof repairs. The new proposal was for \$10,400. The loan amount would include the windows and storm door already installed in the amount of \$1,342.95. The new loan amount requested is \$11,800 making the payment due from John per month at \$119.47. The loan to be amortized over a 10 year period at a rate of 4.0% Interest.
 - Carolyn Brunken made a motion to approve the loan in the amount of \$11,800. Hunter Goldsby seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Bill Drake, Hunter Goldsby, Lorissa Anderson and Carolyn Brunken. Voting Nay: None – MOTION CARRIED
- **Authorization to sign loan documents:** Lorissa Anderson made a motion to approve Gregg Johnson or Hunter Goldsby, whoever is readily available, as authorized signor for the Village of Berwyn for the purposes of the loan documents. Carolyn Brunken seconded the motion. Voting Aye: Bill Drake, Hunter Goldsby, Lorissa Anderson and Carolyn Brunken. Voting Nay: None – MOTION CARRIED
- **Bids on International 2500A Tractor w/loader and 3 point blade:** Notice was placed in the paper as required by State law. At the time of the deadline meeting Clerk has received no bids. The Board was aware of 2 parties that were initially interested in the tractor so will follow-up by reaching out to the individuals to see if there is still some interest. If not, Hunter Goldsby will contact Josh at North Platte Kubota to place the tractor on auction. Will place this item on the Agenda for the March meeting to follow-up.
- **Bridge Inspection:** Chris Jacobsen, Highway Superintendent with the Custer County Highway Department reached out to Hunter Goldsby to remind the Board of Trustees that the Village is required to get a bridge inspection in 2025. Chris is currently looking at bids to have the inspection performed and will include Village of Berwyn in the request for bid proposals.

- Clerk to work on preparing loan documents for John Templin
- Reach out to Troy Gavin at Weathercraft that proposal was accepted for roof repairs
- After the meeting was concluded Carolyn Brunken asked the Board about hosting Vendors within the Village to sell their crafts, and what the cost per Vendor would need to be to organize an event. Will place on March Agenda for further discussion.
- Clerk to follow-up with Anita Sisemore at Dana Cole for assistance in setting up payroll.



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OTHER BUSINESS: NONE


